ChemSec, the International Chemical Secretariat, added 28 new substances to their SIN list of “Substances of Very High Concern” today. The organization also launched a new online tool, SINilarity, which makes it easier to search for information on hazardous chemicals. Chloroethylene, the main ingredient in PVC, was already on SIN list before the update. The importance of choosing a more responsible card material than PVC, like the beautiful and functional wood produced by Sustainable Cards, has been known for a long time.
